WORKSHOP

Using the diverse forest at Camp Adams as a laboratory, participants will learn how forestry practices can improve ecological health and resilience. Workshop participants will learn how forest landowners can access financial and technical assistance to develop stewardship plans incorporating forest carbon, implement practices to improve carbon storage, and gauge their opportunities for deriving income from the carbon market.
